

ADMIRAL PITKA RECON CHALLENGE 2021 (APRC21)

COMPETITORS' MANDATORY EQUIPMENT

1. Competitors' Mandatory Personal Equipment List

- National military battle dress uniform and combat boots;
- Food for three days (Carried by the Competitor);
- Personal first aid kit. Medical supply kit for three days to take care of own medical hygiene: e.g. patches, bandages, disinfection liquid, foot powder, tick removal clamp ect. (Carried by the Competitor);
- Combat knife (blade length at least 12 cm);
- Flashlight or headlamp;
- Water bottle or other water container (e.g. CamelBack);
- Standard issued automatic or semi-automatic rifle (not a submachine gun) and magazines for 120 rounds. At least 120 blank rounds along with blank firing attachment. (Non-Estonian teams will be supported by organisers (AK-4));
- Safety rope (15m, Ø 8 mm, 400 kg capacity) and two carabine hooks for rope;
- Safety Glasses for Shooting (eye protection against tree branches);
- Fire starting tools;
- Compass;
- Whistle.

2. Mandatory Competition Team Equipment

- Field Radio (will be issued by the competition support staff during presentation of competition mandate);
- Permanent marker set (for map marking);
- GPS tracking device (will be issued by the competition support staff during presentation of competition mandate);
- The competition topographic map (will be issued by the competition support staff during presentation of competition mandate);
- Team number including team representative/driver and LNO (will be issued by the competition support staff during presentation of competition mandate).

3. Other Important Information

- There is no limit to the weight and amount of personal equipment, this is not regulated;
- Teams may carry additional items and equipment, if desired. This will be checked prior to the competition. If the items are not consumables (e.g. food, water), then the same items and equipment must be carried by the competitors throughout the competition to the finish line. The umpires will mark all additional equipment at the start;
- Teams are allowed to use mobile phones only in emergency situations;
- Teams are allowed to use night vision devices.
