APPENDIX E-1. COMPETITORS MANDATORY EQUIPMENT

All mandatory equipment must be present at the initial equipment check. Missing mandatory equipment will result in disqualification.

If there are changes in mandatory equipment then registered teams will be notified as soon as possible.

1. Competitors' Mandatory Personal Equipment List

1. National military issue battle dress uniform
2. Military or national ID card
3. Combat boots
4. Tactical gloves
5. Patrol cap or boonie hat
6. Load bearing system (chest rig, harness, etc)
7. Personal first aid kit (tourniquet and field dressing)
8. Standard issue 5,56x45mm automatic or semi-automatic rifle (not a submachine gun)
9. 6 magazines for rifle
10. Blank fire adapter
11. Ballistic protective eyewear and hearing protection (for live firing)
12. Food for three days (72h)
13. Water bottles or hydration bladder (min 3L total)
14. Compass
15. 2x carbine, lockable (min breaking strength 200kg)
16. 180 rounds blank ammunition (issued by the competition support staff)
17. Patrol pack (min. 30 L)
18. Flashlight or headlamp (with red lens)
19. Notebook and stationery (pencil/pen/marker)
20. Face paint
21. GPS tracking device (issued by the competition support staff during of competition mandate)
22. Life coupons (5 pcs) (issued by the competition support staff)

1.1. Competitors suggested equipment

- Tarp or poncho
- Knife
- Sleeping bag
- Beany
- Survival kit
- Spear set of battle dress uniform
- Map case
- Protractor

2. Mandatory Competition Team Equipment

1. mobile phones (min. 2 pcs)
2. Binoculars
3. Multi-tool (leatherman, gerber, etc)
4. Trash bag (min. 60L)
5. Permanent marker set
6. Power bank
7. Matches (min. 2 packs)
8. GPS tracking device for UAV (issued by the competition support staff during presentation of competition mandate)

9. The competition topographic map (issued by the competition support staff during presentation of competition mandate)
10. Team number including team support personnel (issued by the competition support staff during presentation of competition mandate)
11. One UAV per team (has to be taken by the competitors and will be collected by the competition support staff before **START**. The UAV will be used **only** during reconnaissance task, will be handed out before the task and will be collected after the task). **See ANNEX E-5.**

2.2. Suggested team equipment

- Medical supply kit for three days to take care of personal medical needs: e.g. patches, bandages, disinfection liquid, foot powder, tic removal clamp etc.
- GPS device
- Night vision goggles
- Thermal camera
- Canteen kit/ gas stove

3. Extra

- There is no limit to the weight and amount of personal equipment.
- Teams may carry additional items and equipment, if desired. This will be checked prior to the competition. If the items are not consumables (e.g. food, water), then the same items and equipment must be carried by the competitors throughout the competition to the finish line. The umpires will mark all additional equipment at the start.
- Teams are allowed to use night vision devices.
- Optical sights are allowed.
- All equipment should be packed waterproof.
